Greetings Sir Knights,

I hope and pray that all is going well for you and your families and that 2018 has nothing but success waiting for you, both in & out of Masonry. This communication is to be read in entirety in 3 consecutive meetings.

### 40 Mile/\$40 Grand Assessment

Sir Knights, this is the program that was presented at our Workshop last year, and I want to thank the 26 members that paid it immediately on-site because it showed their concern and care about the Grand Commandery's financial situation. The program being a ONE-TIME Grand Assessment of \$40.00 per Sir Knight. Everyone on roll MUST PAY, from the MEGC down. It was all voluntary THEN; however, IT IS THE LAW NOW. It was Motioned, Seconded and the Heal of the Sword sounded on it. It was agreed by the entire membership present at our Grand Conclave last year, not one member voted against it. Individuals told me that they hadn't paid it yet because they hadn't seen it in writing yet. To which I said, if you were in attendance you should know that it goes in effect immediately and that you should inform members that weren't at the Grand Conclave.
